Whereas in the best financial interest, it is the desire of the City of Brookings to sell same as surplus property; and

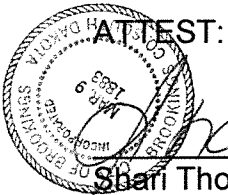
Whereas, the City Manager hereby authorized to sell said surplus property.
