Traffic Safety Committee strives to improve safety and general road conditions for pedestrians and vehicle traffic. Duties and responsibilities of the committee include recommending traffic safety solutions that meet local needs, advise the city manager, city engineer and city council, reviewing and improving traffic and safety applications for funding, responding to public concerns and aiding the overall reduction of traffic accidents. The committee discusses and updates parking, speed limit, stop sign, bicycle traffic and other rules and regulations. There are 13 members on the committee.

- Discussed visibility of the SE corner of the 8<sup>th</sup> St. S. & Main Ave. S. intersection
- Discussed roundabout design at the intersection of Jackrabbit Ave. and University Blvd.
- Discussed the Sketch Plat for 15<sup>th</sup> St. S. between Doral Drive and 22<sup>nd</sup> Ave.
- Recommended 2-way stop signs at the intersection of Copper Mountain Road/Powderhorn Pass and Summit Pass
- Recommended 4-way stop signs at Telluride Lane/Powderhorn Pass at the intersection of Summit Pass
- Recommended a traffic study at 17<sup>th</sup> Ave S and 20<sup>th</sup> St S intersection for possible 4-way stop signs
- Recommended traffic study at the intersection of 15<sup>th</sup> St. S. and Christine Ave. for possible traffic signal or 4-way stop signs
- Recommended locations for digital speed signs
