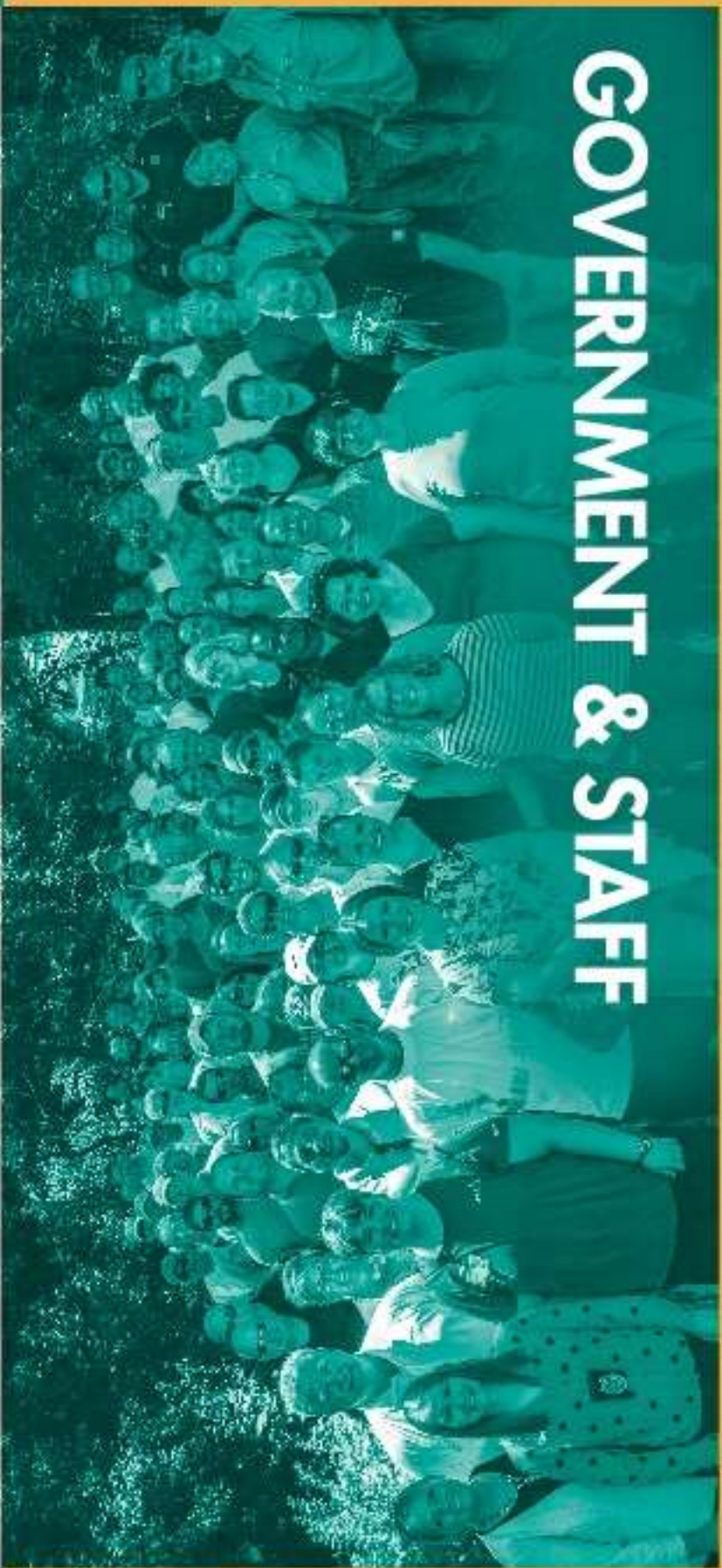
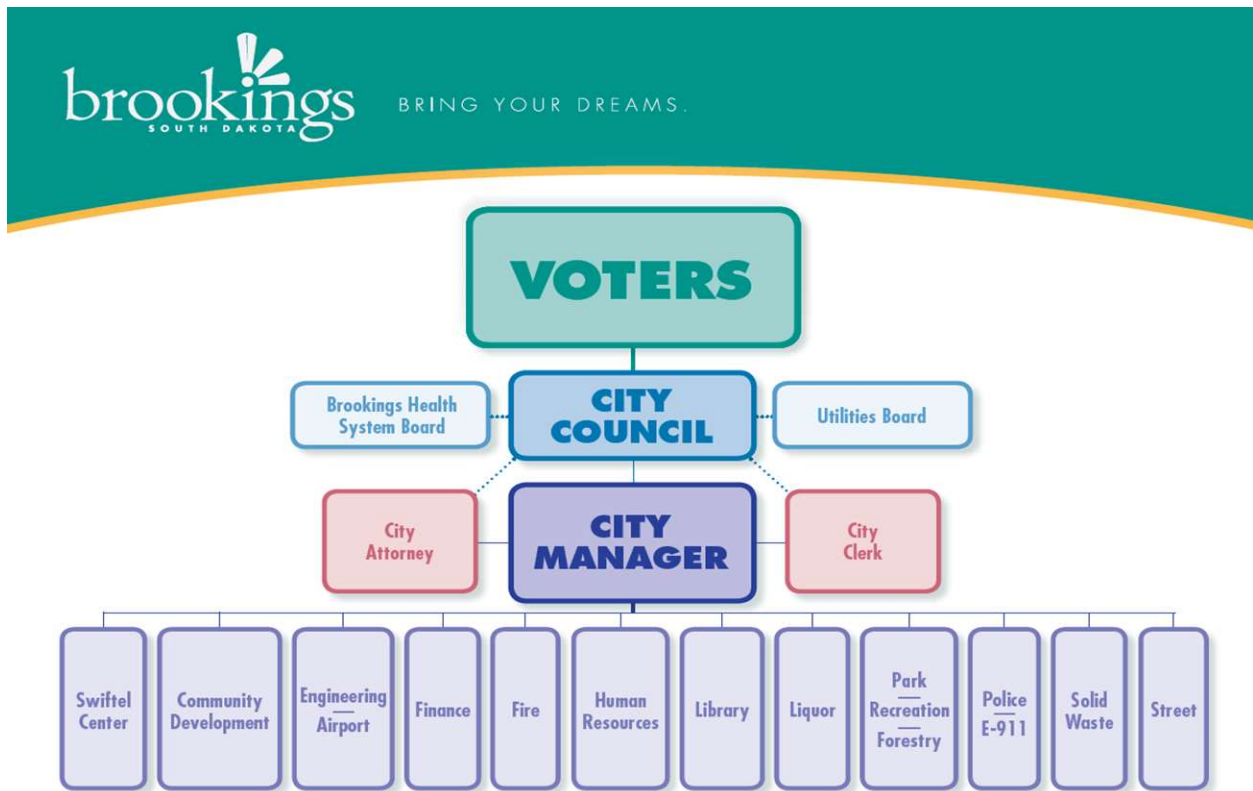

City Government

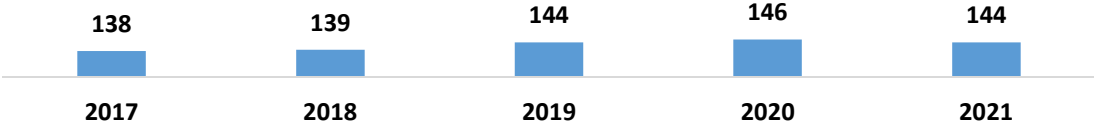
Brookings has a Council-Manager form of government. The City has a seven (7) member elected City Council that is comprised of a Mayor, Deputy Mayor, and five (5) Council Members. The Deputy Mayor is elected by their peers on the City Council on an annual basis to act as Mayor in the absence of the Mayor. City Council is a part-time policy making and legislative body. Members are elected at-large to three (3) year terms. The City Manager is appointed by the City Council to oversee daily operations of City departments.



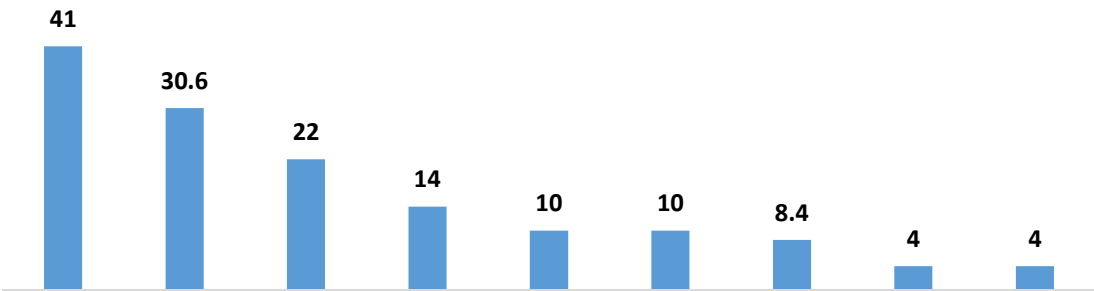
The City Manager, City Attorney, and City Clerk are appointed by the City Council. All other administrative staff are appointed by the City Manager. The Brookings Health System and Brookings Municipal Utilities are entities of the City, but have separate governing bodies.
